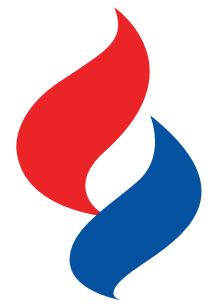

# EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

## FOR 300 UNDERPRIVILEGED STUDENTS

Yayasan MRCB organised a two-day education programme for underprivileged students from all of its four adopted schools located in Kuala Lumpur, Perak and Penang. The programme was conducted separately at the four adopted schools. A total of 300 underprivileged students benefitted from this programme as they learned the techniques to answer questions for four main core subjects (Bahasa Melayu, English, Mathematics and Science).

By the end of the programme, the students gained confidence and felt better prepared to sit for their examinations. And indeed, their examination results showed overall improvements in 2018 compared to the previous year.

Yayasan MRCB's four adopted schools are SK La Salle, Brickfields, SK Iskandar Perdana, Bandar Seri Iskandar, SK Pengkalan Jaya, Butterworth and SK Kuala Perai, Butterworth.

# MOBILE CLINIC

## FOR ORANG ASLI COMMUNITY

Yayasan MRCB continues to impact lives positively through its engagement programme with the Orang Asli community in Sg. Kejar, located within the Royal Belum State Park, in Pulau Banding, Perak.

The Mobile Clinic programme was conducted in December 2018 and benefitted a total of 300 villagers. Yayasan MRCB collaborated with Universiti Kuala Lumpur Royal College of Medicine Perak (UniKL RCMP). More than 45 volunteers consisting of Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) employees, UniKL RCMP and UniKL RCMP's undergraduates were involved in making the programme a success.

The objective of this Mobile Clinic was to provide basic medical and welfare assistance, as well as promote personal hygiene and provide general good health tips to the Orang Asli community. The

three-day and two-night programme included several activities such as health screenings involving blood pressure tests, eye check-ups, height and weight measurements for Body Mass Index, blood glucose testing, minor skin treatments and check-ups for those suffering from diabetes. A demonstration on oral and personal hygiene was also conducted.
